A representative from the Dutch Ministry of Environment will share insights of the Dutch work on this topic.

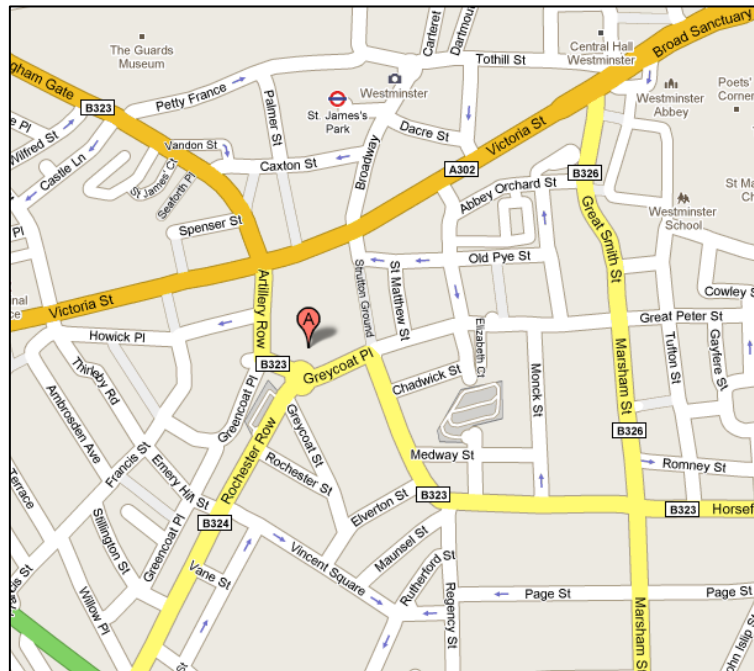
